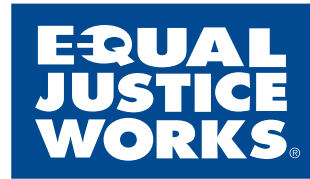
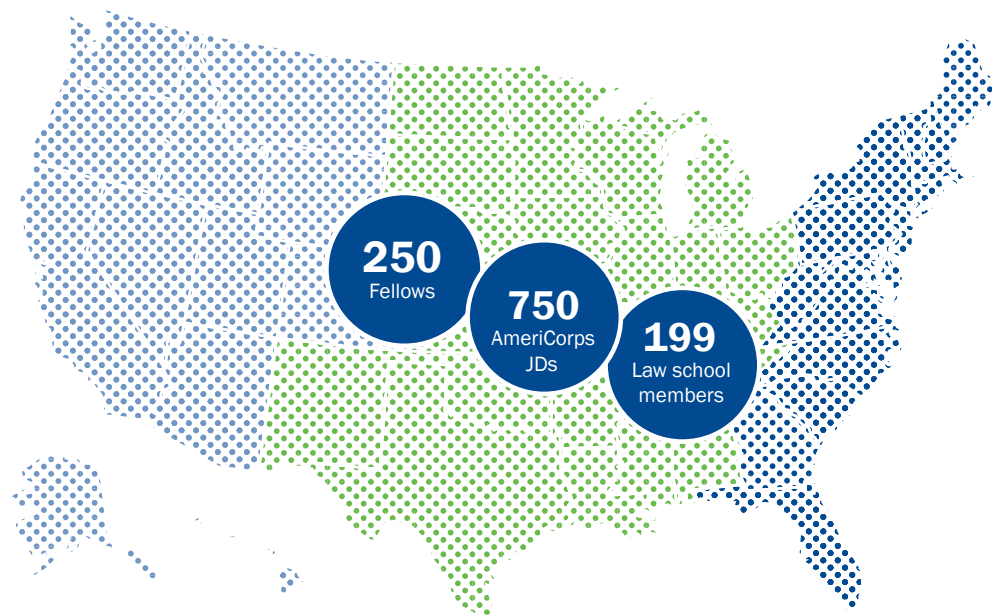


About Us
